# **SHOW RULES**

- 1. Entries must be emailed to: entry@faircountclub.com or mailed to: Faircount, 36 Wendy Road, Milford, CT 06460 and postmarked by Saturday, November 22, 2014. Late entries may be permitted only with prior permission by calling Jon Spodnick at (203) 372-1500.
- 2. Entry fee is \$4.00 per bird. All fees must be mailed with your entry or may be paid electronically at: http://www.faircountclub.com/store.htm
- Make checks payable to: FAIRCOUNT 3.
- The show hall will open at 8:00 A.M. Birds must be 4 cooped by 10:00 A.M. Judging starts at 10:30 A.M. Coop out time is after all judging is complete.
- 5. All birds are to be checked in with the Show Secretary.
- 6. Classes will be provided for Young Hens (YH), Young Cocks (YC), Old Hens (OH) and Old Cocks (OC). Young birds must be 2014 seamless banded.
- 8. Substitutions will be allowed only in the same age, sex and color class.
- 9. Entries must state Breed, Color, Markings, Sex and Band Number.
- 10. Rollers must be entered as one of the following: Show or Flying
- 11. Racing Homers must be entered as: Flown (Racing) or Unflown (Show)
- 12. Saddle and White Homers will be judged in their own class.
- 13. Faircount has the right to combine classes to create competition.
- 14. Junior entries must be 18 or under, please mark entries.
- 15. Judges decision will be final.
- 16. Faircount will not be responsible for the loss, injury, or theft of any bird(s). Pigeons are entered at the sole risk of their owner, although every precaution will be taken.
